BEAUNE 1ER CRU CLOS DES FEVES

"Upright and floral aroma. Springy attack. Plenty of energy. Ripe fruit is lifted with minty and floral notes from the whole-bunch and a distinctive wet herbal twang. I rather like this, as it carries the finish with zingy vibrancy".

BEAUNE 1ER CRU CLOS DES MOUCHES (RED)

"More transparent garnet colour. A bit more muted on the nose than the Grèves. But with lots of dusty sweet fruit to get your teeth into. Broad and satisfying with (just) enough freshness. Quite long and well balanced with a bit of vitality".







PERNAND VERGELESSES 1ER CRU LES CARADEUX

"There is some of the coolness of the appellation on the nose of this wine and then some tightness and filigree nature of the fruit, which certainly isn't heavy. At the moment it's distinctly simple – light lemonade? But it should get there for you, so long as you don't object to the alcohol level".

"Prominent wood and menthol nuances are present on the ripe aromas of dark berries, the sauvage and discreet floral whiffs. The exceptionally rich, suave and plush larger-scaled flavors possess a seductive texture that culminates in a relatively refined and moderately powerful finish. (...)"

GEVREY CHAMBERTIN 1ER CRU LA PERRIERE





"A distinctly ripe nose reflects notes of poached plum, mocha, newly turned earth and forest floor with a background hint of leather. The sleek, intense and solidly voluminous middle weight flavors exude a more subtle minerality on the muscular but not rustic finish. (...)"

BEAUNE 1ER CRU CLOS DES MOUCHES (WHITE)

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU LES CHENEVOTTES


